Combinatorial chemistry comprises chemical synthetic methods that make it possible to prepare a large number (tens to thousands or even millions) of compounds in a single process. Combinatorial chemistry can be used for the synthesis of small molecules and for peptides. These compound libraries can be made as mixtures, sets of individual compounds or chemical structures generated by computer software
