Once the client's objectives are established, they should influence all decisions made by others involved in the project—for example, project managers, designers, contractors, and subcontractors. Resource (project management) Nonstorable resources must be renewed for each time period, even if not used in previous periods. Allocation of limited resources is based on the priority given to each of the project activities. The lack of a resource can therefore be a constraint on the completion of the project activity. These can be people, equipment, facilities, funding, or anything else capable of definition (usually other than labour) required for the completion of a project activity.
