Victorian School of Forestry From 1910 to 1980, 522 students completed the Diploma of Forestry at VSF. The first tertiary forestry school in Australia, VSF was administered by the Forests Commission Victoria (FCV) until 1980, when VSF amalgamated with the University of Melbourne to become that institution's School of Ecosystem and Forest Sciences. As a member of Congress, Owen successfully pushed through the bill that established the Smithsonian Institution and served on the Institution's first Board

of Regents. chargé d'affaires (1853–58) to Naples. Owen also served as a delegate to the Indiana Constitutional Convention in 1850 and was appointed as U. a uniform system of free public schools and established the Indiana Superintendent of Public Instruction 53d833ccf4

Charles Warren Later that year he renamed the four District Superintendents (ranking between the Superintendents and Sir Charles Warren (7 February 1840 – 21 January 1927) was a British Army officer of the Royal Engineers. Much of his military service was spent in British South Africa. of the Order of the Bath (KCB) on 7 January 1888. He was one of the earliest European archaeologists of the Biblical Holy Land, and particularly of the Temple Mount. Previously he was Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, the head of the London Metropolitan Police, from 1886 to 1888 during the Jack the Ripper murders. His command in combat during the Second Boer War was criticised, but he achieved considerable success during his long life in his military and civil posts 53d833ccf4

It was commissioned by Francis Egerton, 3rd Duke of Bridgewater, to transport coal from his mines in Worsley to Manchester. It was opened in 1761 from Worsley to Manchester, and later extended from Manchester to Runcorn, and then from Worsley to Leigh.
