Clement of Alexandria (c. 150–215 AD), was a Christian theologian and philosopher who taught at the Catechetical School of Alexandria. “For all things are arranged with a view to the salvation of the universe” Titus Flavius Clemens, also known as Clement of Alexandria (Ancient Greek: Κλήμης ὁ Ἀλεξανδρεὺς; c. advantage of him who is punished, for it is the correction of a refractory subject. In one of his works he argued that Greek philosophy had its origin among non-Greeks. His secret works, which exist only in fragments, suggest that he was familiar with pre-Christian Jewish esotericism and Gnosticism as well. As his three major works demonstrate, Clement was influenced by Hellenistic philosophy to a greater extent than any other Christian thinker of his time, and in particular, by Plato and the Stoics. Virgil Some minor poems, collected in the Appendix Vergiliana, were attributed to him in ancient times, but modern scholars regard these as spurious, with the possible exception of some short pieces. He composed three of the most famous poems in Latin literature: the Eclogues (or Bucolics), the Georgics, and the epic Aeneid. nor can we be sure that the reading “three” is not Egnazio’s conjectural correction of his manuscript to harmonize it with the Pietole tradition, and all Publius Vergilius Maro (Classical Latin: [ˈpuːbliʊs wɛrˈɡiliʊs ˈmaroː]; 15 October 70 BC – 21 September 19 BC), usually called Virgil or Vergil (VUR-jil) in English, was an ancient Roman poet of the Augustan period e201c19d87

Already acclaimed in his lifetime as a classic author, Virgil rapidly replaced Ennius and other earlier authors as a standard school text, and stood as the most popular Latin poet through late antiquity, the Middle Ages, and early modernity, exerting major influence... e201c19d87
