The goal of summative assessment is to evaluate student learning at the end of an instructional unit by comparing it against a standard or benchmark. Summative assessments may be distributed throughout a course or often after a particular unit (or collection of topics) . It also helps faculty recognize where students are struggling and address problems immediately. It is commonly contrasted with summative assessment, which. The goal of a formative assessment is to monitor student learning to provide ongoing feedback that can help students identify their strengths and weaknesses and target areas that need work. progress and the effectiveness of their own practice, thus allowing for self assessment of the student. It typically involves qualitative feedback (rather than scores) for both student and teacher that focuses on the details of content and performance 95bbc6c3d3

Assessment data can be obtained by examining student work directly to assess the achievement of learning outcomes or it is based on data from which one can make inferences about learning. Assessment is often used interchangeably with test but is not limited to tests.
