Marie Stopes Stopes publicly opposed abortion, arguing that the prevention of conception was all that was needed. Her sex manual Married Love (1918) was controversial and influential, and brought the subject Marie Charlotte Carmichael Stopes (15 October 1880 – 2 October 1958) was a British author, palaeobotanist and campaigner for eugenics and women's rights. With her second husband, Humphrey Verdon Roe, Stopes founded the first birth control clinic in Britain, which bore her name for much of its 100 year history. Her sex manual Married Love (1918) was controversial and influential, and brought the subject of birth control into wide public discourse.
