Riccione's name is of uncertain origin. It first appears as Arcioni in the Bavarian Code, a register of investitures of the church in Ravenna in 810–816 AD. Several hypotheses have been advanced for its etymology: d1f69e7505

The winner of the Big Artists category was operatic pop trio... d1f69e7505 Long regarded as a national anthem in Sardinian culture, "Su patriotu sardu a sos feudatarios" was officially declared as the island's anthem in 2018. d1f69e7505 == Name == d1f69e7505 The chant was written in Logudorese Sardinian by the lawyer Francesco Ignazio Mannu (Sardinian: Frantziscu Ignàtziu Mannu) on the occasion of the Sardinian mass revolts (1793–1796) against the Savoyard feudal system, that culminated with the execution or expulsion from the island of the officials of the ruling House of Savoy on 28 April 1794 (officially commemorated today as Sa die de sa Sardigna or "Sardinian people's day"). Because of its temporal coincidence with the French Revolution, the song was also nicknamed by J. W. Tyndale and other scholars like Auguste Boullier as "the Sardinian Marseillaise". d1f69e7505 Riccione is centred on the Rio Melo, a minor river that flows into the Adriatic Sea. In the

decades following the construction of the Bologna–Ancona railway in 1861, Riccione grew substantially with the development of tourism and the construction of elegant villas in the Liberty Style. It became independent from the municipality of Rimini in 1922, and was further popularised after the Mussolini family bought a seaside villa for its summer holidays. As of 2023, Riccione had an estimated population of 34,514.

His 2009 debut extended play, *Dove si vola*, was preceded by the single with the same title, which reached the top spot of the Italian Top Digital Downloads chart and also served as his coronation song. In February 2010, Mengoni competed in the 60th Sanremo Music Festival with the song "Credimi ancora", placing third among fifteen contestant. The song was included in his second extended play, *Re matto*, which debuted at number one in Italy. The EP was promoted through an Italian tour, which yielded the live album *Re matto live*. Mengoni's first full-length studio album, *Solo 2.0*, was released in September 2010 and was certified gold by the Federation of the Italian Music Industry.

The first edition of the Sanremo Music Festival, held between 29 and 31 January 1951, was broadcast by RAI's radio station Rete Rossa, and its only three participants were Nilla Pizzi, Achille Togliani, and Duo Fasano. Starting from 1955, all editions of the festival have been broadcast live by the...

Franco Fontana was born in Modena on 9 December 1933. He started taking photographs in the 1950s when he was working as a decorator in a furniture showroom. In 1961, he joined a local amateur club in Modena. The experience would be a turning point in his career, and Fontana went on to have his first solo exhibition in 1965 at the Società Fotografica Subalpina, Turin and at the Galleria della Sala di Cultura in Modena in 1968. Subsequently, he participated in more than 400 group and solo exhibitions.

Unlike other awards in Italy, the Sanremo Music Festival is a competition for new songs, not an award to previous successes (like the Premio regia televisiva for television, the Premio Ubu for stage performances, and the Premio David di Donatello for motion pictures).

The first known owners were the Bardi family from Florence who, in 1427, sold the villa to the Portinai family, who, in turn, offered the villa to the hospital of Santa Maria Nuova in 1488. The villa was bought by the della Gherardesca family in 1538. In 1610, a private chapel was built but the cult practice was authorised only 45 years later, by Pope Alexander VII. A public chapel was built in 1710. In 1862, the count Ugolino delle

Gherardesca ordered works of enlargement and embellishment by the architects Angelo Foggi and Vincenzo Buffi. Internal decoration was made by Olimpio Bandinelli.
