Grade inflation With grades allocated on a normative basis with approximately Grade inflation (also known as grading leniency) is the general awarding of higher grades for the same quality of work over time, which devalues grades. However, higher average grades in themselves do not prove grade inflation. approximately 36% of pupils entered for a Mathematics exam sat the O-Level and 64% the CSE paper. For this to be grade inflation, it is necessary to demonstrate that the quality of work does not deserve the high grade d3ae45ceff

Unified State Exam The USE in Russian language and mathematics is obligatory; that means that every student must achieve the necessary results in these subjects to enter any Russian university or obtain a high school diploma. The USE simultaneously acts as both a school graduation examination and an entrance examination for higher education institutions, ensuring that students meet standardized educational requirements.
