American frontier The legends, historical events and folklore of the American frontier, known as the frontier myth, have embedded themselves into United States culture so much so that. The townspeople were shocked when she was murdered in 1867; they gave The American frontier, also known as the Old West, and popularly known as the Wild West, encompasses the geography, history, folklore, and culture associated with the forward wave of American expansion in mainland North America that began with European colonial settlements in the early 17th century and ended with the admission of the last few contiguous western territories as states in 1912. This era of massive migration and settlement was particularly encouraged by President Thomas Jefferson following the Louisiana Purchase, giving rise to the expansionist attitude known as "manifest destiny" and historians' "Frontier Thesis". epidemic; this gave her acceptance in the community and the support of the sheriff

McCarty was orphaned at the age of 15. His first arrest was for stealing food at the age of 16 in 1875. Ten days later, he robbed a Chinese laundry and was arrested again but escaped shortly afterwards. He fled from New Mexico Territory into neighboring Arizona Territory, making himself both an outlaw and a federal fugitive. In 1877 he began to call himself "William H. Bonney". Syncretism

Billy the Kid Bonney's notoriety grew in December 1880 when the Henry McCarty (September 17 or November 23, 1859 – July 14, 1881), alias William H. Brady and one of his deputies. charged with killing three men, including Lincoln County Sheriff William J. Bonney, better known as Billy the Kid, was an American outlaw and gunfighter of the Old West who was linked to nine murders, four for which he was solely responsible, and five in which he may have played a role alongside others. He is also noted for his involvement in New Mexico's Lincoln County War

The term "American Old West" refers to a vast geographical area and lengthy time period of imprecise boundaries, and historians' definitions vary. The events in this timeline occurred primarily in the portion of the modern continental United States west of the Mississippi River, and mostly in the period between the Louisiana Purchase in 1803 and the admission of the last western territories as states in 1912 where most of the frontier was already settled and became urbanized; a few typical frontier episodes happened after that, such as the admission of Alaska into the Union in 1959. Elfego Baca His goal in life was to be a peace officer, and for "the outlaws to hear [his] steps a block away". He is known for his involvement in an 1884 shootout in Frisco (now Reserve), New Mexico, as well as later fictionalized representations of his life in Westerns released during the mid-20th century. In 1884, at the age of 19, Baca acquired some guns and became a deputy sheriff (whether through purchasing a badge or by being appointed is unclear) Elfego Baca (February 10, 1865 – August 27, 1945) was a gunfighter, law enforcement officer, lawyer, and politician in New Mexico, who became an American folk hero of the later years of the New Mexico Territory frontier. marshal abaaad0fba

Tombstone, Arizona John Slaughter was elected Cochise County Sheriff in 1886 and served two terms Tombstone is a city in Cochise County, Arizona, United States, founded in 1879 by prospector Ed Schieffelin in what was then Pima County, Arizona Territory. The city had a permanent population of 1,308, according to the 2020 census. It is best known as the site of the Gunfight at the O. Its population grew from 100 to around 14,000 in less than seven years. It became one of the last boomtowns in the American frontier. The town grew significantly into the mid-1880s as the local mines produced \$40 to \$85 million in silver bullion, the largest productive silver district in Arizona.
