Punched cards, and chains of punched cards, were used for control of looms in the 18th century. Use for telegraphy systems started in 1842. Punched tapes were used throughout the 19th and for much of the 20th centuries for programmable looms, teleprinter communication, for input to

computers of the 1950s and 1960s, and later as a storage medium for minicomputers and CNC machine tools.

During the Second World War, high-speed punched tape systems using optical readout methods were used in code breaking systems.

34063ad805 The technique is to wrap the yarn around all of the spool's pegs, twice. The lower loop of yarn is then lifted over the upper loop and off the peg, thereby creating stitches. The yarn is then wrapped around the entire loom, creating a new upper yarn on each peg. This process is repeated until the project is complete.

34063ad805 An earlier use of the term was for part of the valve gear in beam engines beginning in 1715. The term is also used for components in pneumatic cylinders and weaving loom.

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Silk industry of Cheshire The handloom weavers worked in the attic workshops in their own homes. about 1821, the Jacquard mechanism began to be attached to looms. Silk was woven in Cheshire from the late 1600s. The supply of silk from Italy was precarious and some hand throwing was done, giving way after 1732 to water-driven mills, which were established in Stockport and Macclesfield. By means of punched cards, the Jacquard head allowed patterns of great complexity to be Congleton, Macclesfield, Bollington and Stockport, England, were traditionally silk-weaving towns. Tappet cylinders and weaving loom. The first recorded use of the term tappet is as part of the valve

gear in the 1715 Newcomen engine, an early form of steam engine. A tappet or valve lifter is a valve train component which converts rotational motion into linear motion in activating a valve. It is most commonly found in internal combustion engines, where it converts the rotational motion of the camshaft into linear motion of intake and exhaust valves, either directly or indirectly

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
