Passengers aboard his vessels sometimes included notable people, including Abraham Lincoln. During much of his career LaBarge was in the employ of the American Fur Company, a giant in the fur trading business, before building his own steamboat, the Emilie, to become an independent riverman. After a failed attempt to recapture Petra in 549, the Byzantine emperor Justinian I sent an army under Bessas to retake the fortress. This conquest gave the Sassanian Empire access to the Black Sea and marked the beginning of the Lazic War. During the fighting, the wooden tower from which the defenders were frantically The siege of Petra was fought in 550 AD, between the Byzantines (East Romans) under general Bessas, and the Sasanian Persian garrison of Petra in the buffer state of Lazica.
