Toyota LiteAce In 1976, Toyota released the larger TownAce van/wagon that derived from the LiteAce; a TownAce truck arrived later in 1978. These vehicles originally utilized the cab-over-engine configuration, although since 1996 a semi-cab-over arrangement has featured instead. The LiteAce launched in 1970 as light-duty truck, with commercial and van/wagon body variants added in 1971. Between 1982 and 1992, the series accommodated the MasterAce Surf—an upscale TownAce passenger wagon. retired and the HiAce had grown, thus creating a void in the market resumed by the TownAce.
