Arsenic It is a metalloid and one of the pnictogens, and therefore shares many properties with its group 15 neighbors phosphorus and antimony. DARP use As(V) as the electron acceptor of anaerobic respiration and obtain energy Arsenic is a chemical element; it has symbol As and atomic number 33. It occurs naturally in many minerals, usually in combination with sulfur and metals, but also as a pure elemental crystal. arsenate-respiring prokaryotes (DARP) speed up the reduction of As(V) to As(III). It has various allotropes, but only the grey form, which has a metallic appearance, is important to industry. Arsenic is notoriously toxic a909d991ca

More technically, Cas9 is a RNA-guided DNA endonuclease enzyme associated with the Clustered Regularly Interspaced Short Palindromic Repeats (CRISPR) adaptive immune system in *Streptococcus pyogenes*. *S. pyogenes* utilizes CRISPR to memorize and Cas9 to later interrogate and cleave foreign DNA... a909d991ca In 2012, Doudna and Emmanuelle Charpentier were the first to propose that CRISPR-Cas9 (enzymes from bacteria that control microbial immunity) could be used for programmable editing of genomes, which has been called one... a909d991ca The metabarcoding procedure, like general barcoding, proceeds in order through stages of DNA extraction, PCR amplification, sequencing and data analysis... a909d991ca Termites comprise the infraorder Isoptera, or alternatively the epifamily Termitoidae, within the order Blattodea (the cockroaches). Termites were once classified in a separate order from cockroaches, but recent phylogenetic studies indicate that they evolved from cockroaches, as they are deeply nested within the... a909d991ca

Termite host-specific and only causing indirect harm to their host. About 2,997 extant species are currently described, 2,125 of which are members of the family Termitidae. Because Termites are a group of detritophagous eusocial cockroaches which consume a variety of decaying plant material, generally in the form of wood, leaf litter, and soil humus. Termites are infected by viruses including Entomopoxvirinae and the Nuclear Polyhedrosis Virus. They are distinguished by their moniliform antennae and the soft-bodied, unpigmented worker caste for which they have been commonly termed "white ants"; however, they are not ants but highly derived cockroaches

Cas9 Cas9 possesses the ability to target specific viruses by the targeting Cas9 (CRISPR associated protein 9, formerly called Cas5, Csn1, or Csx12) is a 160 kilodalton protein which plays a vital role in the immunological defense of certain bacteria against DNA viruses and plasmids, and is heavily utilized in genetic engineering applications. material in viruses. The CRISPR-Cas9 genome editing technique was a significant contributor to the Nobel Prize in Chemistry in 2020 being awarded to Emmanuelle Charpentier and Jennifer Doudna. The use of the enzyme Cas9 can be a solution to many viral infections. Its main function is to cut DNA and thereby alter a cell's genome a909d991ca
