Palmiro Togliatti Cazzullo, Aldo (8 November 2020). Considered one of the founding fathers of the Italian Republic, he led Italy's Communist party from a few thousand members in 1943 to two million members in 1946. Born into a middle-class family, Togliatti received an education in law at the University of

Turin, later served as an officer and was wounded in World War I, and became a tutor. Corriere della Sera (in Italian) Palmiro Michele Nicola Togliatti (Italian: [pal'mi:ro toʎ'ʎatti] ; 26 March 1893 - 21 August 1964) was an Italian politician and statesman who led the Italian Communist Party (Partito Comunista Italiano, PCI) for nearly forty years, from 1927 until his death. Described as "severe in approach but extremely popular among the Communist base" and "a hero of his time, capable of courageous personal feats", his supporters gave him the nickname *il Migliore* ("The Best"). In 1930, Togliatti renounced Italian citizenship, and he became a citizen of the Soviet Union; upon his death, a Soviet city was named after him. deal, before signing him fully from Milan, for whom he never made a first team appearance, in 2011. == Club career == 13cf1eb37a Maradona played for Argentinos Juniors, Boca Juniors, Barcelona, Napoli, Sevilla and Newell's Old Boys during his club career. He led Napoli to their first Serie A league title, and their second three years later; he was later banned from the club for taking cocaine.
