Early identification of lesions by radiography is not possible, but over time areas of radiographic opacity develop in association with the damaged Dysbaric osteonecrosis or DON is a form of avascular necrosis where there is death of a portion of the bone that is thought to be caused by nitrogen (N₂) embolism (blockage of the blood vessels by a bubble of nitrogen coming out of solution) in divers. symptoms 14d4bbe98a

Since bubbles can form in or migrate to any part of the body, DCS can produce many symptoms, and its effects may vary from joint pain and rashes to paralysis and death... 14d4bbe98a Risk factors include bone fractures, joint dislocations, alcoholism, and the use of high-dose steroids. The condition may also occur without any clear reason. The most commonly affected bone is the femur (thigh bone). Other relatively common sites include the upper arm bone, knee, shoulder, and ankle. Diagnosis is typically by medical imaging such as X-ray, CT scan, or MRI. Rarely biopsy may be used. 14d4bbe98a About 25% of melanomas develop from moles. Barotrauma Complete blood count (CBC) Arterial blood gas (ABG) determination Imaging: Chest radiography can show pneumothorax, and is indicated if there is chest discomfort Barotrauma is physical damage to body tissues caused by a difference in pressure between a gas space inside, or in contact with, the body and the surrounding gas or liquid. Barotrauma can occur during both compression and decompression. Tissue rupture may be complicated by the introduction of gas into the local tissue or circulation through the initial trauma site, which can cause blockage of circulation at distant sites or interfere with the normal function of an organ by its presence. The term is usually applied when the gas volume involved already exists prior to decompression. The initial damage is usually due to over-

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stretching the tissues in tension or shear, either directly by an expansion of the gas in the closed space or by pressure difference hydrostatically transmitted through the tissue 14d4bbe98a

DCS and arterial gas embolism are collectively referred to as decompression illness 14d4bbe98a

Avascular necrosis Early on, there may be no symptoms. Complications may include collapse of the bone or nearby joint surface. increased radiographic opacity, as dead bone cannot undergo bone resorption which is carried out by living osteoclasts. Late radiographic signs also Avascular necrosis (AVN), also called osteonecrosis or bone infarction, is death of bone tissue due to interruption of the blood supply. Gradually joint pain may develop, which may limit the person's ability to move 14d4bbe98a
