In practice, it is calculated using different techniques, and its value ranges between 0 and 1, where 0 indicates no probability of success while 1 indicates definite success. It can be subdivided into architect-led design-build (ALDB, sometimes known as

designer-led design-build) and contractor-led design-build. engineering into the design process at the onset of a project. The products developed by a commercial organisation provide the means to generate income. Design projects last from a few weeks to three years with an average of one year. Product development also includes the renewal of an existing product and introducing a product into a new market.
