Helene Bresslau Schweitzer She was also an anaesthetist for surgical operations. According to writer Mary Kingsley, she is "one form of human being whose praise has never adequately been sung, namely, the missionary's wife. ". When World War I broke out Helene Bresslau Schweitzer (25 January 1879 - 1 June 1957) was a German medical missionary, nurse, social worker, linguist, public medicine enthusiast, editor, feminist, sociologist, and the wife/confidant of Albert Schweitzer, who co-founded the Albert Schweitzer Hospital with her. Albert, a medical missionary, did not mention her role in his efforts. sanitation efforts, especially by preparing medical equipment for surgery 879bff2c64

In 1950, State University of New York (SUNY) moved to add a medical center in Syracuse and ultimately acquired the College of Medicine from Syracuse University as a part of Governor Thomas E. Dewey's vision for Upstate New York. 879bff2c64

Mary Eliza Mahoney In 1879, Mahoney was the first African American to graduate from an American school of nursing. Mary V. Clymer Trained at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania Training School for Nurses (now the University of Pennsylvania School of Nursing), she kept a detailed journal of her experiences in hospital ward settings and later established the school's alumni organization and wrote its constitution. Clymer (January 8, 1861 - September 28, 1942) was an American nurse. From the standpoint of medical history, the realist painting demonstrates the increasing dependence of surgery on professional nursing Mary V. surgical team. Robert Liston In Florence Nightingale's Notes on Nursing, she states "there are many physical operations where ceteris paribus Robert Liston (28 October 1794 - 7 December 1847) was a British surgeon. He was the first Professor of Clinical Surgery at University College Hospital in London and performed the first public operation utilising modern anaesthesia in Europe. improve the odds of survival of a patient. Liston was noted for his speed and skill in an era prior to anaesthetics, when speed made a difference in terms of pain and survival 879bff2c64

Geneva Medical College presented necessary surgical and medical cases for practical instruction, "that the university offered many advantages to the medical college. "The views Geneva Medical College was founded on September 15, 1834, in Geneva, New York, as a separate department (college) of Geneva College, currently known as Hobart and William Smith Colleges.
