Colleges and universities in the US and elsewhere may grant placement and course credit to students who obtain qualifying scores on the examinations

AP Psychology is often considered one of the easier AP exams; relative to the other tests, the material is rather straightforward and much easier to self-study. Among all the social studies Advanced Placement exams, the Psych exam had the second-highest passing rate in 2018.

AP Psychology It was the shortest AP exam until the AP Physics C exam was split into two separate exams in 2006. on the multiple-choice section are based only on the number of questions answered correctly. Grading Advanced Placement (AP) Psychology (also known as AP Psych) and its corresponding exam are part of the College Board's Advanced Placement Program. This course is tailored for students interested in the field of psychology and as an opportunity to earn Advanced Placement credit or exemption from a college-level psychology course. This course is equivalent to a one semester, non-calculus-based introductory college statistics course and is normally offered to sophomores, juniors and seniors in high school. In the United States, enrollment in AP Statistics classes has Advanced Placement (AP) Statistics (also known as AP Stats) is a college-level high school statistics course offered in the United States through the College Board's Advanced Placement program

AP Art and Design requires students to submit a portfolio for review. AP Computer Science Principles requires students to complete the Create task, which is part of the AP grade for the class. One of the College Board's more recent additions, the AP Statistics exam was first administered in May 1996 to supplement the AP program's math offerings, which had previously consisted of only AP Calculus AB and BC. In the United States, enrollment in AP Statistics classes has increased at a higher rate than in any other AP class.

Error Carried Forward As such, if the answer to any part is incorrect, all subsequent parts will be incorrect, even if the approach for said subsequent parts was correct. The purpose of Error Carried Forward is to protect students who run into this issue from being penalized not only for the initial error, but for all subsequent errors that are only incorrect in answer, not approach. ECF in both the AP Calculus AB and AP Physics B exams. In questions with multiple parts, it is common that the answer to the current part builds on an answer to the previous part. However, the college board does not award ECF marks if an incorrect answer changes the latter parts Error Carried Forward (ECF) is an informal principle for school exam grading employed within computational fields of study such as mathematics, physics, engineering and computer science

The AP curriculum for each of the various subjects is created for the College Board by a panel of experts and college-level educators in that academic discipline. For a high school course to have the designation as offering an AP course, the course must be audited by the College Board to ascertain that it satisfies the AP curriculum as specified in the Board's Course and Examination Description (CED). Advanced Placement exams Calculus BC has a Calculus AB subscore, which has equivalent value to taking the AP Caclulus AB exam. performance on all other questions. AP exams (with few exceptions) have a multiple-choice section and a free-response section. Some colleges and universities Advanced Placement (AP) examinations are exams offered in United States by the College Board and are taken each May by students.
