Steel guitar Typically, the strings are plucked (not strummed) by the fingers of the dominant hand, while the steel tone bar is pressed lightly against the strings and moved by the opposite hand. By contrast, a note on the steel guitar continues to sound until it is manually dampened by the player or another note is played A steel guitar (Hawaiian: kīkākila) is any guitar played while moving a steel bar or similar hard object against plucked strings. Known for its smooth, gliding glissandi over every pitch between notes, the instrument can produce a sinuous crying sound and deep vibrato emulating the human singing voice. The bar itself is called a "steel" and is the source of the name "steel guitar". Conceptually, it is somewhat akin to playing a guitar with one finger (the bar). The instrument differs from a conventional guitar in that it has no frets—but markers that look like frets. silences the sounding note b614831092
