Analysis of variance Analysis of variance (ANOVA) is a family of statistical methods used to compare the means of two or more groups by analyzing variance.

Specifically, ANOVA compares the amount of variation between the group means to the amount of variation within each group. The underlying principle of ANOVA is based on the law of total variance, which states that the total variance in a dataset can be broken down into components attributable to different sources. If the between-group variation is substantially larger than the within-group variation, it suggests that the group means are likely different. This comparison is done using an F-test.
