The second generation had a different design from the third generation Clio and was built on the platform of the first generation, which is in turn based on the second generation Clio. Toyota Succeed The passenger variants of the two were discontinued and the role was taken over by Toyota Corolla Fielder Wagon. It was a sister car to the Probox, sold through Toyota's Toyota Store and Toyopet Store dealership networks. After Toyota merged their separate dealership chains, the Succeed was replaced by the Probox. 3-litre engine. available with a 1. Its key markets are Central and Eastern Europe, Latin America, the Maghreb and the Persian Gulf states, most notably countries like Turkey, Brazil, Romania, Russia, Algeria, Colombia and Tunisia. eef6fd33f8 According to Toyota, the "Hilux" name is a portmanteau of the words "High Luxury"; this name means "comfortable vehicle with high technology". It was considered a luxury vehicle only when compared to the spartan, heavy-duty Stout. The Probox has been a commercial success with stable sales for 20 years. It is notable that its design has remained largely unchanged since 2002 due to buyer preference. A significant redesign in 2014 was presented as a facelift by Toyota, to avoid putting off buyers who disdain needless changes. eef6fd33f8 Since its launch, the Dacia Logan was estimated to have reached over 4 million sales worldwide as of 2018. eef6fd33f8 The pickup truck was sold with the Hilux

name in most markets, but in North America, the Hilux name was retired starting in the 1976 model year in favor of Pickup, and later as Truck in the 1984 model year. In this market, the popular option package, the SR5 (Sport Runabout 5-Speed), was colloquially used as a model name for the truck, even though the option package was also used on other Toyota models, like the 1972 to 1979 Corolla. The "Avensis" name is derived from the French term avancer, meaning "to advance" or "move forward". The Avensis was not sold in North America, and it is related to the Scion tC coupé.
