Strength of materials materials. In the mechanics of materials, the strength of a material is The strength of materials is determined using various methods of calculating the stresses and strains in structural members, such as beams, columns, and shafts. In addition, the mechanical element's macroscopic properties (geometric properties) such as its length, width, thickness, boundary constraints and abrupt changes in geometry such as holes are considered. The methods employed to predict the response of a structure under loading and its susceptibility to various failure modes takes into account the properties of the materials such as its yield strength, ultimate strength, Young's modulus, and Poisson's ratio. An important founding pioneer in mechanics of materials was Stephen Timoshenko

The reliability function is theoretically defined as the probability of success.
