Above this temperature it is the most paramagnetic element. hydroxide ($\text{Gd}(\text{OH})_3$): $2 \text{Gd} + 6 \text{H}_2\text{O} \rightarrow 2 \text{Gd}(\text{OH})_3 + 3 \text{H}_2$. When separated, it usually has impurities of the other rare earths because of their similar chemical properties. It is a silvery-white metal when oxidation is removed. Gadolinium is a malleable and ductile rare-earth element. Gadolinium below its Curie point of 20 °C (68 °F) is ferromagnetic, with an attraction to a magnetic field higher than that of nickel c3d42aa704
