Qin dynasty It is named for its progenitor state of Qin, a fief of the confederal Zhou dynasty (c. 475–221 BC). dynasty of China. The Qin dynasty's 14-year existence was the shortest of any major dynasty in Chinese. Beginning in 230 BC, the Qin under King Ying Zheng engaged in a series of wars conquering each of the rival states that had previously pledged fealty to the Zhou. The classic account of the Shang comes from texts such as the Book of Documents, Bamboo Annals and Shiji. The dynasty was briefly interrupted by the Xin dynasty (9–23 AD) established by the usurping regent Wang Mang, and is thus separated into two periods—the Western Han (202 BC – 9 AD) and the Eastern Han (25–220 AD). Spanning over four centuries, the Han dynasty is considered a golden age in Chinese history, and had a permanent impact on Chinese identity in later periods.
