Cultural consensus theory The theory is designed Cultural consensus theory is an approach to information pooling (aggregation, data fusion) which supports a framework for the measurement and evaluation of beliefs as cultural; shared to some extent by a group of individuals. Cultural consensus models guide the aggregation of responses from individuals to estimate (1) the culturally appropriate answers to a series of related questions (when the answers are unknown) and (2) individual competence (cultural competence) in answering those questions. The agreement between pairs of individuals is used to estimate individual cultural competence. The theory is applicable when there

is sufficient agreement across people to assume that a single set of answers exists. Answers are estimated by weighting responses of individuals by their competence. a single set of shared answers and then estimating the answers and individual cultural competence in answering the questions 55723828f9

Linear discriminant analysis However Linear discriminant analysis (LDA), normal discriminant analysis (NDA), canonical variates analysis (CVA), or discriminant function analysis is a generalization of Fisher's linear discriminant, a method used in statistics and other fields, to find a linear combination of features that characterizes or separates two or more classes of objects or events. The resulting combination may be used as a linear classifier, or, more commonly, for dimensionality reduction before later classification. used to answer the same research questions.
