Pauline Baynes S. Late in her life she began to write and illustrate her own books, with animal or Biblical themes. She was the first illustrator of some of J. R. R. Tolkien's works, gaining a reputation as the "Narnia artist", she illustrated spinoffs like Brian Sibley's *The Land of Narnia*. volumes of C. S. Gaining a reputation as the "Narnia artist", Pauline Diana Baynes (9 September 1922 – 1 August 2008) was an English illustrator, author, and commercial artist. She illustrated all seven volumes of C. Tolkien's minor works, including *Farmer Giles of Ham*, *Smith of Wootton Major*, and *The Adventures of Tom Bombadil*.

Introduced in 1996's *A Game of Thrones*, thirteen-year-old Daenerys is one of the last surviving members (along with her older brother, Viserys III, the "Beggar King") of House Targaryen, which, until 14 years before the events of the first novel, had ruled Westeros from the Iron Throne for nearly 300 years before being ousted. She subsequently appeared in *A Clash of Kings* (1998) and *A Storm of Swords* (2000). Daenerys was one of a few prominent characters not included in 2005's *A Feast for Crows* but returned in the next novel, *A Dance with Dragons* (2011).

The subjects - dragons, dwarfs, giants - are presented as being potent and strong at the dawn of time, but magical creatures grow weaker and eventually disappear as humans spread and demystify the world, though there is always the promise that the magic will return once again.
