Disaster response It includes warning and evacuation, search and rescue, providing immediate assistance, assessing damage, continuing assistance, and the immediate restoration or construction of infrastructure. Disaster response refers to the actions taken directly before, during, or immediately after a disaster. The objective is to save lives, ensure health Disaster response refers to the actions taken directly before, during, or immediately after a disaster. An example of this would be building provisional storm drains or diversion dams. It can involve specific but limited aid, such as helping refugees with transport, temporary shelter, and food. Emergency response aims to provide immediate help to keep people alive, improve their health and support their morale. Or it can involve establishing semi-permanent settlements in camps and other locations.
