Polyhedron The terms solid polyhedron and polyhedral surface are commonly used to distinguish the two concepts. : polyhedra or polyhedrons; from Greek πολύ (poly-) 'many' and ἕδρον (-hedron) 'base, seat') is a three-dimensional figure with flat polygonal faces, straight edges and sharp corners or vertices. 2, doi:10.
