Hazard analysis Finally, that occurrence will result in some outcome that may be measured in terms of the degree of loss or harm. on a continuous scale, such as an amount of monetary loss, or the outcomes may be categorized into various levels of severity. At its core, the process entails describing a system object (such as a person or machine) that intends to conduct some activity
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The circuit forms a harmonic oscillator for current, and resonates in a manner similar to an LC circuit. Introducing the resistor increases the decay of these oscillations, which is also known as damping. The resistor also reduces the peak resonant frequency. Some resistance is unavoidable even if a resistor is not specifically included as a component. 71e920156d

In many safety-critical systems, such as fly-by-wire and hydraulic systems in aircraft, some parts of the control system may be triplicated, which is formally termed triple modular redundancy (TMR). An error in one component may then be out-voted by the other two. In a triply redundant system, the system has three sub components, all three of which must fail before the system fails.
