Śāriputra He is considered the first of the Buddha's two chief male disciples, together with Maudgalyāyana (Pali: Moggallāna). Śāriputra had a key leadership role in the ministry of the Buddha and is considered in many Buddhist schools to have been important in the development of the Buddhist Abhidharma. Buddhist Śāriputra (Sanskrit: शारिपुत्र; Tibetan: ཤ་རི་ཕུ་ཌཱ་ག་ལཱ་ཡཱ་ན་པཱ་ལ་, Pali: Sāriputta, lit. He frequently appears in Mahayana sutras, and in some sutras, is used as a counterpoint to represent the Hinayana school of Buddhism

This discourse is recorded in Theravada Buddhism's Pali Canon's Khuddaka Nikaya in two places: in the Khuddakapāṭha (Khp 5), and in the Sutta Nipāta (Sn 2.4). In the latter source, the discourse is called the Maḥāmaṅgala Sutta. It is also traditionally included in books of 'protection' (paritta). It is also found in the Tibetan Canon, in the Kangyur (བཀའ་འགྱུར་བཙུན་པཱ་ལ་).

Ten principal disciples The ten disciples are mentioned in the Mahāyāna text Vimalakīrti-nideśa, among others. clairvoyance and the practice of the four foundations of mindfulness (satipatthana). They are mentioned in Chinese texts from the fourth century BCE until the twelfth century CE, and are the most honored of the groups of disciples, especially so in China and Central Asia. The ten disciples can be found as an iconographic group in notable places in the Mogao Caves. Aniruddha was a cousin of Shakyamuni Buddha. In this text, they are called the "Ten Wise Ones" (pinyin: shih-che), a term which is normally used for the disciples of Confucius. In early Vedic literature, the good Asuras are called Adityas and are led by Varuna, while the malevolent ones are called Danavas and are led by Vritra.

Maṅgala Sutta Kangyur (བཀའ་འགྱུར་བཙུན་པཱ་ལ་). In this discourse, Gautama Buddha describes 'blessings' that are wholesome personal pursuits or attainments, identified in a progressive manner from the mundane to the ultimate spiritual goal. The discourse was preached at Jetavana Temple in answer to a question asked by a deva as to which things in this world could truly be considered The Maṅgala Sutta is a discourse (Pali: sutta) of Gautama Buddha on the subject of 'blessings' (mangala, also translated as 'good omen' or 'auspices' or 'good fortune'). In Sri Lanka, this sutta considered to be part of "Maha Pirith"

Mahākāśyapa He is regarded in Buddhism as an enlightened disciple, being foremost in ascetic practice. He was considered to be the first patriarch in a number of Early Buddhist schools and continued to have an important role as patriarch in the Chan/Zen tradition.
