SNMP is widely used in network management for network monitoring. JPEG XS It is a special-purpose codec that is specifically designed to allow for low-complexity and low-latency implementations. Although there is not an official acronym definition, XS was chosen to highlight the extra small and extra speed characteristics of the codec. Construction began in 1968 and elements of the first version of the network, the Mark I, became operational in early 1969 then fully operational in January 1970. The Mark II version operated from 1973 until 1986. The NPL network was the first computer network to implement packet switching and the first to use high-speed links. Its original design, along with the innovations implemented in the ARPANET and the CYCLADES network, laid down the technical foundations of the modern Internet. 5da63869e9
