They were intended to drop away once expended. Such rocket boosters were limited to a short burn duration, were typically solid-fuel and suitable for only a single use. experimental prototypes such as the American McDonnell Douglas F-15 STOL/MTD 25cf2748ea

Skylab It was operated by three trios of astronaut crews: Skylab 2, Skylab 3, and Skylab 4. Skylab was constructed from a repurposed Saturn V third stage (the S-IVB), and took the place of the stage during launch. Skylab's orbit eventually decayed and it disintegrated in the atmosphere on July 11, 1979, scattering debris across the Indian Ocean and Western Australia. Operations included an orbital workshop, a solar observatory, Earth
