Scots law Scots law recognises four sources of law: legislation, legal precedent, specific academic writings, and custom. It is a hybrid or mixed legal system containing civil law and common law elements, that traces its roots to a number of different historical sources. Legislation affecting Scotland and Scots law is passed by the Scottish Parliament on all areas of devolved responsibility, and the United Kingdom Parliament on reserved matters. Scots law, English law and Northern Irish law in areas such as property law, criminal law, trust law, inheritance law, evidence law and family law while Scots law (Scottish Gaelic: Lagh na h-Alba) is the legal system of Scotland. Together with English law and Northern Irish law, it is one of the three legal systems of the United Kingdom.
