History of the Catholic Church in Japan Beginning in 1587, with imperial regent Toyotomi Hideyoshi's ban on Jesuit missionaries, Christianity was repressed as a threat to national unity. Only after the Meiji Restoration was Christianity re-established in Japan. Emperor Ōgimachi issued edicts to ban Catholicism in 1565 and 1568, but to little effect. Many Catholics went underground, becoming hidden Christians (隠れキリシタン, kakure kirishitan), while others died.
