Candidate examples of natural kinds are found in all the sciences, but the field of chemistry provides the paradigm example of elements. Some treat it as a classification identifying some structure of truth and reality that exists whether or not humans recognize it. Alexander Bird and Emma Tobin see natural kinds as relevant to metaphysics, epistemology, and the philosophy of language, as well as the philosophy of science. Others treat it as intrinsically useful to the human mind, but not necessarily reflective of something more objective 5a10f06622
