The Encyclopædia Britannica has been published continuously since 1768, appearing in fifteen official editions. Several editions were amended with multi-volume "supplements" (3rd, 4th/5th/6th), several consisted of previous editions with added supplements (10th, 12th, 13th), and one represented a drastic re-organization (15th). Textual criticism is a branch of textual scholarship, philology, and
literary criticism that is concerned with the identification of textual

variants, or different versions, of either manuscripts (mss) or of printed books. Such texts may range in dates from the earliest writing in cuneiform, impressed on clay, for example, to multiple unpublished versions of a 21st-century author's work. This means that unintentional alterations were common when copying manuscripts by hand 4ee2ba3b47

Critica Botanica Linnaeus had learned plant names as short Critica Botanica ("Critique of botany", Leiden, July 1737) was written by

Swedish botanist, physician, zoologist and naturalist Carl Linnaeus (1707–1778). European scientists, a comprehensive global Flora for its day, and by the 10th edition had reached over 3000 species. The first edition was published in July 1737 under the full title *Critica botanica in qua nomina plantarum generica, specifica & variantia examini subjiciuntur, selectoria confirmantur, indigna rejiciuntur; simulque doctrina circa denominationem plantarum traditur*.
