Statistical hypothesis test A statistical hypothesis test typically involves a calculation of a test statistic. Roughly 100 specialized statistical tests are in use and noteworthy. Then a decision is made, either by comparing the test statistic to a critical value or equivalently by evaluating a p-value computed from the test statistic. This therapy focuses on challenging unhelpful and irrational negative thoughts and beliefs, referred to as 'self-talk' and replacing them with more rational positive self-talk. It was developed by psychoanalyst Aaron Beck in the 1950's
