Economists since Adam Smith and David Ricardo have advocated this tax because it does not hurt economic activity, and encourages development without subsidies. The land value tax has been referred to as "the perfect tax" and the economic efficiency of a land value tax has been accepted since the eighteenth century. Expatriation tax expatriation tax or emigration tax is a tax on persons who cease to be tax-resident in a country. In most cases, expatriation tax is assessed upon change of domicile or habitual residence; in the United States, which is one of only three countries (Eritrea and Myanmar are the others) to substantively tax its overseas citizens, the tax is applied upon relinquishment of American citizenship, on top of all taxes previously paid. Australia has "Deemed disposal tax" which in essence is exit tax. An environmental tax, ecotax (short for ecological taxation), or green tax is a tax levied on activities which are considered to be harmful to the environment An environmental tax, ecotax (short for ecological taxation), or green tax is a tax levied on activities which are considered to be harmful to the environment and is intended to promote environmentally friendly alternatives via economic incentives. Often, an ecotax policy proposal may attempt to maintain overall tax revenue by proportionately reducing other taxes (e. One notable example is a carbon tax. Such a policy can complement or avert the need for regulatory (command and control) approaches. Ecotaxes address the failure of free markets to consider environmental impacts. g ca55738cda

Often a property tax is levied on real estate. It may be imposed annually or at the time of a real estate transaction, such as in real estate transfer tax. This tax can be contrasted with a rent tax, which is based on rental income or imputed rent, and a land value tax, which is a levy on the value of land, excluding the value of buildings and other improvements. ca55738cda

Carbon tax This negative externality can be reduced by taxing carbon content at any point in the product cycle. A carbon tax is a tax levied on the carbon emissions from producing goods and services. Greenhouse gas emissions cause climate change. When a fossil fuel such as coal, petroleum, or natural gas is burned, most or all of its carbon is converted to CO₂. Carbon taxes are intended to make visible the hidden social costs of carbon emissions. This both decreases demand for goods and services that produce high emissions and incentivizes making them less carbon-intensive. Green liberalism The term "green liberalism" was coined by political philosopher Marcel Wissenburg in his 1998 book Green Liberalism: The Free and The Green Society. This view tends to dominate the movement, although. Bright Green liberalism, or liberal environmentalism, is liberalism that includes green politics in its ideology. Similarly, the British Liberal Democrats have drawn on the same concept to propose a "Green Tax Switch". However, he rejects the control of population growth and any control over the distribution of resources as incompatible with individual liberty, instead favoring supply-side control: more efficient production and curbs on overproduction and overexploitation. He argues that liberalism must reject the idea of absolute property rights and accept restraints that limit the freedom to abuse nature and natural resources. Green liberals are

In contrast, countries with lower levels of secrecy but also low "effective" rates of taxation, most notably Ireland in the FSI rankings, appear in most \$ Tax haven lists.
