networks that internally match limit orders and charge a very small per share transaction fee (often a fraction of a cent per share). An ECN is generally an electronic system accessed by an electronic trading platform that widely disseminates orders entered by market makers to third parties and permits the orders to be executed against them in whole or in part.
