Materialism Later Indian materialist Jayaraashi Bhatta (6th century) in his work *Tattvopaplavasimha* Materialism is a form of philosophical monism in metaphysics, according to which matter is the fundamental substance in nature, and all things,

including mental states and consciousness, are results of material interactions. Materialism directly contrasts with monistic idealism, according to which consciousness is the fundamental substance of nature. According to philosophical materialism, mind and consciousness are caused by physical processes, such as the neurochemistry of the human brain and nervous system, without which they cannot exist. was a Chinese thinker of the early Common Era said to be a materialist
