Colonialism Collins English Dictionary Colonialism is the practice of extending and maintaining political, social, economic, and cultural domination over a territory and its people by another people in pursuit of interests defined in an often distant metropole, who also claim superiority. While frequently an imperialist project, colonialism functions through differentiating between the targeted land and people, and that of the colonizers (a critical component of colonization). Colonialism sometimes deepens by developing settler colonialism, whereby settlers from one or multiple colonizing metropolises occupy a territory with the intention of partially or completely supplanting the existing indigenous. The concept entered the forefront of academia in the late 20th century, followed by the development of postcolonialism. disputed. Rather than annexation, this typically culminates in organizing the colonized into colonies separate to the colonizers' metropole

Indigenous feminism feminism diverges from postcolonial feminism, as some have argued that postcolonial theory in general has largely ignored the histories of colonialism Indigenous feminism is an intersectional theory and practice of feminism that focuses on decolonization, Indigenous sovereignty, and human rights for Indigenous women and their families. The focus is to empower Indigenous women in the context of Indigenous cultural values and priorities, rather than mainstream, white, patriarchal ones. As a professor of literature at Columbia University, he was among the founders of post-colonial studies. As a cultural critic, Said is best known for his book *Orientalism* (1978), a foundational text which critiques the cultural representations that are the bases of Orientalism—how the Western world perceives the Orient. Another book in this area is *Postcolonial Theory* (1998) Edward Wadie Said (1 November 1935 – 24 September 2003) was a Palestinian-American academic, literary critic, and political activist. His model of textual analysis transformed the academic discourse of researchers in literary theory, literary criticism, and Middle Eastern studies a8ca0db26d

The field started to emerge in the 1960s, as scholars from previously colonized countries began publishing on the lingering effects of colonialism, developing an analysis of the history, culture, literature, and discourse of imperial power

Numerous scholars and human rights agencies assert that since the onset of the insurgency in Jammu and Kashmir in 1988, rape has been leveraged as a 'weapon of war' by Indian security forces comprising the Indian Army, Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) and Border Security personnel. However, the government rejects such charges. He received the 1992 Nobel Prize in Literature. His works include the Homeric epic poem *Omeros* (1990), which many critics view "as Walcott's major achievement." In addition to winning the Nobel Prize, Walcott received many literary awards over the course of his career, including an Obie Award in 1971 for his play *Dream on Monkey Mountain*, a MacArthur Foundation "genius" award, a Royal Society of Literature Award, the Queen's Medal for Poetry, the inaugural OCM Bocas Prize for Caribbean Literature, the 2010 T. S. Eliot Prize for his book of poetry *White Egrets* and the Griffin Trust For Excellence in Poetry Lifetime Recognition Award in 2015.

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
