Industrial manufacture consists of predetermined, standardized and repeated, often automated, acts of replication, while craft-based design is a process or approach in which the form of the product is determined personally by the product's creator largely concurrent with the act of its production. It is the creative act of determining and defining a product's form and features, which takes place in advance of the manufacture or production of the product

This is usually where the major cost benefits of the application of design for assembly occur. If a product contains fewer parts it will take less time to assemble, thereby reducing assembly costs. even with products assembled by manual assembly. In addition, if the parts are provided with features which make it easier to grasp, move, orient and insert them, this will also reduce assembly time and assembly costs. The reduction of the number of parts in an assembly has the added benefit of generally reducing the total cost of parts in the assembly b5f25e8829
