

# Goal Setting Guide

For many sports, each goal structure usually consists of two vertical posts, called goal posts, supporting a horizontal crossbar. A goal line marked on the playing surface between the goal posts demarcates the goal area. Thus, the objective is to send the ball or puck between the goal posts, under or over the crossbar (depending on the sport), and across the goal line. Goal celebration Celebrations are generally more substantial in lower-scoring sports, such as association football and ice hockey, where a score has greater significance. Whilst referring to the celebration of a goal in general, the term can also be applied to specific actions, such as a player removing their shirt or performing a somersault. Path-goal theory The theory states that a leader's behavior is contingent to the satisfaction, motivation and performance of his or her subordinates. According to Robert House and John Antonakis, the task-oriented elements of the path-goal model can be classified as a form of instrumental leadership. The path-goal theory, also known as the path-goal theory of leader effectiveness or the path-goal model, is a leadership theory developed by Robert House, an Ohio State University graduate, in 1971 and revised in 1996. that when a coach is clear in setting goals and expectations, the goals are more likely to be achieved than if the goals and expectations are unclear. Goal setting is a major component of personal-development and management literature. Studies by Edwin A. Goal setting can be guided by goal-setting criteria (or rules) such as SMART criteria. In doing so, the goal setter has established a desired future state which differs from their current state thus creating a mismatch which in turn spurs future actions. Goals are more deliberate than desires and momentary intentions. Therefore, setting goals means that a person has committed thought, emotion, and behavior towards attaining the goal 2b2acdde82

Goals breakdown structure The highest-level defines the overall goal or mission for the project. The next layer down defines the specifications each product. Like the WBS, project goals exhibit a hierarchical structure. The next layer down defines the features the products must exhibit to achieve the organization's goals. Bender embellished on the topic in his second book, A Manager's Guide to Project Management In The goals breakdown structure (GBS) is a hierarchical structure linking high-level objectives or goals to more detailed goals. The next level down sets the goals the organization intends to achieve from the project. The GBS was originally developed for project management, but applies to product development and the organization as a whole. The concept is based on the Work Breakdown Structure (WBS) popular in the project management discipline.
