Due to his long publication history and broad scope of activities, Superman's adversaries exist in every known capacity: humans, metahumans, androids, sorcerers, empowered animals, other aliens (such

as Kryptonians), mythical/supernatural creatures, corrupt doppelgängers of himself (imposters, clones, or parallel universe counterparts), interdimensional beings (Mr. Mxyzpltk, Vindktvx), and even deities. of supervillains appearing in DC Comics who are or have been enemies of the superhero Superman. Superman began as one of several anthology features in the National Periodical Publications comic book Action Comics #1 in June 1938. In May 2006, it was returned to its original title and numbering. A sixth Superman series was released in February 2023. A fourth series was released in June 2016 and ended in April 2018, while the fifth series was launched in July 2018 and ended in June 2021. Superman is an ongoing American comic book series featuring the DC Comics superhero Superman as its protagonist. The title was canceled with issue #714 in 2011, and was relaunched with issue #1 the following month which ended its run in 2016. Between 1986 and 2006 it was retitled The Adventures of Superman, while a new series used the title Superman. The series was replaced by Superman: Son of Kal-El in July 2021, featuring adventures of Superman's son, Jon Kent b0801442d3

The first issue was written by Louise Simonson and featured pencils by Jon Bogdanove, Tom Grummett, Bob McLeod, and Dan Jurgens. Inks were by Dennis Janke, Jerry Ordway, and Brett Breeding. Simonson wrote issues #1-56, 59-83, 86, #0 and Annuals #2, 4, and 6 from 1991 to 1999. Bogdanove pencilled issues #1-68, 75-82, 85, and #0 during the same period and returned for the final issue, #134, in 2003. b0801442d3
