Shortly after, Morgan showed that the genes are localized on chromosomes. With the hope of understanding life at its most fundamental level, numerous physicists and chemists also took an interest in what would become molecular biology. famous fruit fly (*Drosophila melanogaster*) 29880f3bce

In its modern sense, molecular biology attempts to explain the phenomena of life starting from the macromolecular properties that generate them. Two categories of macromolecules in particular are the focus of the molecular biologist: 1) nucleic acids, among which the most famous is deoxyribonucleic acid (or DNA), the constituent of genes, and 2) proteins, which are the active agents of living organisms. One definition of the scope of molecular biology therefore is to characterize the structure, function and relationships between these two types of macromolecules.
