The modern depiction of Baphomet was popularized in the 19th century by French occultist Éliphas Lévi, who portrayed it as a winged humanoid with a goat's head, embodying a synthesis of opposites such as male and female, good and evil, and human and animal. This image, known as the "Sabbatic Goat," features the Latin words "Solve" (dissolve) and "Coagula" (coagulate), reflecting the alchemical process of transformation

Freemasonry is considered the oldest existing secular fraternal organisation, with documents and traditions dating back to the 14th century. These painted depictions of Masonic themes are exhibited in the lodge according to which degree is being worked and are Freemasonry (sometimes spelled Free-Masonry) consists of fraternal groups that trace their origins to the medieval guilds of stonemasons
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Anglo-American style Freemasonry, which insists that a "volume of sacred law", such as the Bible, Quran or other religious text should be open in a working lodge, that every member should profess belief in a supreme being, that only men should be admitted, and discussion of religion or politics does not take place within the lodge.
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Sixth and Seventh Books of Moses Self-described as "the wonderful arts of the old Hebrews, taken from the Mosaic books of the Kabbalah and the Talmud", it is actually a grimoire, or text of magical incantations and seals, that purports to instruct the reader in the spells used to create some of the miracles portrayed in the Bible as well as to grant other forms of good fortune and good health. It was also influential in Christian occult movements in Anglophone West Africa, and West African religious movements The Sixth and Seventh Books of Moses is an 18th- or 19th-century magical text allegedly written by Moses, and passed down as hidden (or lost) books of the Hebrew Bible. Adonhiramite Rite Though no longer widely practiced The Adonhiramite Rite is a Masonic system consisting of 33 grades or degrees, The founding of the Adonhiramite Rite is traditionally attributed to Louis Guillermin Saint-Victor, a French Freemason who, in 1781, published the first significant work on the rite, entitled "Recueil Précieux de la Maçonnerie Adonhiramite" (Precious Compilation of Adonhiramite Freemasonry). This rite combines Templar, Rosicrucian and other esoteric influences into a unique Masonic structure.
