They can also include computers and sensors that monitor performance and plan movement, often called mechanical systems. The term is commonly applied to artificial devices, such as those employing engines or motors, but also to natural biological macromolecules, such as molecular machines. Rieger Orgelbau The firm was founded by Franz Rieger. The Rieger tradition was also continued by the owners and workers of the original firm, who moved to Austria and founded a new workshop as "Rieger Orgelbau". From 1873 it was known as Rieger & Söhne, and from 1879 as Gebrüder Rieger, after his sons took over. of materials – the pipe shop, the locksmith shop, and the workshops for production of manuals and action parts – are located on the same premises as the Rieger Orgelbau is an Austrian firm of organ builders, known generally as Rieger.
