Relationship maintenance Scholars define relational maintenance in four different ways: to keep a relationship in existence, to keep a relationship in a specified state or condition, to keep a relationship in a satisfactory condition, and to keep a relationship in repair. Social information processing (theory) It suggests that people rely heavily on the social information available to them in their environments, including input from colleagues and peers, to shape their attitudes, behaviors, and perceptions. This theory explores

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how individuals make decisions and form attitudes in a social context, often focusing on the workplace. people develop and manage relationships in a computer-mediated environment. Mediated communication Mediated communication or mediated interaction (less often, mediated discourse) refers to communication carried out by the use of information communication Mediated communication or mediated interaction (less often, mediated discourse) refers to communication carried out by the use of information communication technology and can be contrasted to face-to-face communication. Thus, Davis defines mediated communication as the use of any technical medium for transmission across time and space.
