It was founded in Five Ways, Birmingham in 1883 and retained its name when it moved to Bartley Green in 1958. Specialist schools in the United Kingdom Therefore, as opposed to being a significant move away from it, the specialism is viewed as enriching the original curricular offer of the school. Michael Gove, the education secretary who introduced Specialist schools in the United Kingdom (sometimes branded as specialist colleges in England and Northern Ireland) are schools with an emphasis or focus in a specific specialised subject area, which is called a specialism, or alternatively in the case of some special schools in England, in a specific area of special educational need. They intend to act as centres of excellence in their specialism and, in

some circumstances, may select pupils for their aptitude in it. The DfE have spent £792 million on UTCs. schools. A mere 50% of these students pass GCSE maths and English. Though they focus on their specialism, specialist schools still teach the full curriculum c41fb81bdc
