Toyota Auris United Kingdom began on 1 July 2010, at a price starting at £18,950 (US\$27,450), £550 (US\$800) less than the Toyota Prius. Introduced in 2006, the first generation three/five-door hatchback shared the platform with the E150 series Corolla, while the second generation five-door hatchback and station wagon called "Touring Sports" uses the E180 platform. The "Auris" name is based on the Latin word for "gold", "aurum". Hybrid Synergy Drive Previously, Toyota also licensed its HSD technology to Nissan for use in its Nissan Altima Hybrid. First introduced on the Prius, the technology is an option on several other Toyota and Lexus vehicles and has been adapted for the electric drive system of the hydrogen-powered Mirai, and for a plug-in hybrid version of the Prius.
